
Who We Help

- 80% are ages 18-35

- 67% have incomes under \$5,000
- 19% are TEA recipients

- 66% lack a savings account
- 54% do not own a car
- 90% do not own a home
- 13% consider transportation a significant barrier






Percent of All Graduates Placed in Jobs
